



Nordic Championship and Danish National Championship in Artistic Swimming May 09th-12th 2024 in Copenhagen, Denmark

The Danish Artistic Swimming Federation has the pleasure to invite artistic swimmers born before 2011 to the Nordic Junior and Senior Championship and Danish Junior, Senior and Masters Championship in Artistic Swimming to be held from 9th to the 12th of May 2024.

Medals: 1st, 2nd and 3rd place medals are awarded for all events. There are separate

medal award ceremonies for Nordic Club Cup and Danish Championships.

Number of participants: For Junior and Senior, each club can participate with 3 male solos, 3 female

solos, 3 duets, 3 mixed duets, one team, one combination and one acrobatics





team in line with the Nordic Championship rules. Danish participants with no restrictions for the Danish Championships.

If a club would like to have more than the permitted number of routines (both juniors and seniors) an application can be made to be entered into the competition either as pre-swimmer or given there is space in the program.

Entries: Preliminary entries are to be received before 1st of March 2024 (template

attached).

The final entry should be received on the 9th of April 2024.

Coach cards should be received on the **26th of April 2024**. And please respect this date to avoid changing all material for the judges and having to make changes in the scoring program. Changes after this date will only be accepted in case of injury or sickness.

Entry Fee: Solo 30 EURO per entry

Duet 40 EURO per entry Team 60 EURO per entry

Invoice will be sent after the final entry date. The clubs have 14 days to make the payment. Payments will be checked before the competition; without payment the competitor cannot start. The fee of late payment is equal to the amount of the payment.

Judges and DTC/STC: Each participating club and/or national federation is required to bring judges.

1-5 participants
6-10 participants
1 judge
2 judges
10+ participants
3 judges

WA-listed judges or judges who have passed the test at a FINA school are preferred; however, clubs/nations can choose to send any judge eligible to judge at national level. Cost on not presenting an eligible judge for the competition is **200 EURO.**

Each Nordic nation should bring at least one DTC and STC who has completed a minimum of training to national certified standard. If your country does not have a DTC/STC you can apply to be exempt, if there are enough DTC/STC's.





Governing rules: The competition will be held according to the WAQ 2022-2025 rules with

some exceptions. Participants from the age of 13 can take part in junior solo/duet and team Junior/Senior events. In Free Combination for Juniors and Seniors – the same rules as for Youth, but no restriction to the Degree of Difficulties of the Acros. In addition, rules for the Nordic Championship will

be followed for that part of the competition. No finals will be held.

Music: WA rules AS 15.3. Team managers and coaches are responsible for

submitting their music electronically in .mp3 format no later than $\mathbf{26}^{\text{th}}\,\mathbf{of}$

April 2024 to synkrodk@gmail.com. Each submission shall be labeled:



Competition Area:

Diving pool $25m \times 12,5m \times 3,8m$ deep. See plan below. The Starting point for the music program is along the back wall, and stairs for leaving the pool are at the same corner.



Lockers: There are lockers in the changing rooms. You close the locker, press a code of 4 numbers. It's for free.

To the left of the building with access through Bellahøjvej. Parking is also available at Borups Alle by Spunsvæggen. But there are only a limited number of parking spaces, so public transportation is advised.

Transportation: The most convenient way to get to the swimming pool is by public transport.

BUS 26, 5C, 68 250S and 350S stops right outside the swimming pool. It is 1,8km to walk to the nearest S-train station. It is 45-60 minutes from the Airport to the swimming pool with public transport, change at Nørreport (city

center) to the bus 5C. In taxi or car it takes 30 minutes from the airport/bridge to Sweden/Malmø to the swimming pool.

Food: We kindly ask the participating teams to provide food for themselves. The

pool is located in the center of Copenhagen with several supermarkets, restaurants and fast food shops close to the pool. Food is only to be consumed in the bleachers and common areas outside the pool.

Accommodation: We kindly ask the participating teams to reserve the accommodation

themselves. Copenhagen gives a wide array of options for accommodation

from AirBnB, hostels to hotels close to the pool.

Starting order: Drawing of start lists will occur by the referee no later than 48 hours before

the competition and provided on the various communication platforms.

Opening ceremony: Opening ceremony will be held on Friday evening. Gathering place will be

announced closer to date. Dress in club and national team gear for the ceremony. Parade takes place in alphabetical order of clubs/nations with the

host clubs last.

Awards ceremony: The awards ceremony will take place after the sessions are completed on

each competition day. Please wear the club/national team uniforms.

Results: Preliminary results are given right after the subsequent swimmer for all

programs. All results are preliminary until checked by the referee/chief recorder. Completed result lists at the latest after the competition.
