Participants will gain insight into the revised Table of Difficulty (ToD), new synchronization and acrobatic guidelines, and hands-on practice with the updated Coach Cards. The curriculum is tailored to ensure coaches and judges are equipped to apply these changes effectively in both competitive and training environments.
