Friday, December 12th - Sunday, December 14th, 2025

VFNUF:

The competition will be held at the Mäkelänrinne Swimming Center (Mäkelänkatu 49, 00550 Helsinki).

The diving pool features two 1 meter springboards, two 3 meter springboards, and diving platforms at heights of 1 meter, 3 meters, 5 meters, 7.5 meters, and 10 meters. During the competition the diving land area is also in use.

TECHNICAL MEETING:

Thursday, December 11th, at 19:00 at Mäkelänrinne.

ENTRIES:

Each participating nation may enter a maximum of 2 divers per individual discipline. In sychronised and team events participating country can enter only one team per discipline. Entries should be submitted electronically via the Divecalc online entry system. Each country will receive a Divecalc-link that the country needs to use for enries.

RESULTS SERVICE:

Live streams will be available. More information will follow later.

AWARDS:

Medals are awarded to the divers who finish first, second, and third in each age group and discipline, as well as to teams in team/synchro events.

Points are calculated to facilitate an official international competition among countries. Points are awarded for both individual and team/synchro events as follows: 10-8-7-6-5-4-3-1 points. The title of "Best Nation" will be awarded in both junior and senior age groups.





ACCOMMODATION:
